The State of Wisconsin mandates you license your dog(s). Per State Statute 174.05 Dog License Tax. (1): REQUIREMENT. Except as provided in s. 174.054, the owner of a dog more than 5 months of age on January 1 of any year, or 5 months of age within the license year, shall annually, or on or before the dog becomes 5 months of age, pay the license tax and obtain a license. To license your dog in Ludington, you can do so at the annual Ludington Rabies Clinic generally held in February, or you can complete this form and send it along with a copy of current rabies vaccination and payment to the Ludington Treasurer. If you have questions, you can call the Ludington Treasurer at 715-877-2762.

NOTE: Failure to comply with the mandate to license your dog(s) on time will result in additional fees and potential fines, something no one wants, including the Ludington Board. Late fees/fines are assessed beginning April 1st. Please make everything easy and license your dog(s).
